Course Objectives

1. Course Description ENGL103 is an ESP course which offers a comprehensive introduction and overview of medical terminology. It is designed to build a working medical vocabulary by combining the most frequently encountered prefixes, suffixes, word roots and combining forms. Medical terms are introduced in the context of basic anatomy and physiology with emphasis on body systems: their main structures, functions, pathologies, medical procedures, common terms, and abbreviations. This course is a blend of classroom and online lab learning.
2. Course Main Objective The objective of English 103 is to facilitate students' productivity in their future health science studies. Upon successful completion, students will have acquired a medical vocabulary that enables them to demonstrate basic knowledge of word structure and body systems in order to communicate in health sciences.
