Course Objectives

1. Course Description

This course introduces and provides the student with an overview of a variety of topics within Forensic Medicine and Toxicology. Concepts covered in this course include an introduction to principles of forensic pathology, medico-legal systems, types of injuries/assault, and illicit drugs/poisons and their clinical correlation.

- To enable students to become familiar with the terminology and problems of Forensic medicine.
